

Temporary Grounds Maintenance

Central Weber Sewer Improvement District is seeking qualified applicants to work on the temporary grounds maintenance crew. This is a temporary seasonal position. The standard schedule will be Monday – Thursday, up to 30 hours a week. However, the work schedule may be flexible. Work season will be from approximately April 1st to November 1st, weather and workload permitting.

RATE OF PAY: \$18 per hour, depending on experience and qualifications.

Minimum Requirements

High School Diploma or GED required. The successful candidate must be able to pass a physical examination, background check, and drug screening prior to employment.

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must have a valid Utah Driver's License and driving record

Essential Job Functions

Works under the Direction of the Pretreatment/Buildings and Grounds Supervisor and the Lead Grounds Technician.

The job will consist of operating industrial lawn mowers, string trimming, maintaining and monitoring the facility grounds, including sprinkler system repair and maintenance. Must be able to perform a variety of entry-level semi-skilled duties related to these job requirements including, but not limited to, irrigation and landscape installation, chemical application, and maintenance of equipment and hand tools.

Performs other duties as assigned.

Working Conditions & Physical Requirements

The grounds to be maintained are located at a wastewater treatment facility. Must be able to safely work at this facility, which includes exposure to confined spaces, high voltage equipment, dust, heat, cold, dampness, disagreeable odors, noise, heights, unknown levels of pathogenic bacteria, and other environmental aspects which may be considered unfavorable or disagreeable. Potential exists for exposure to hazardous chemicals and gases including chlorine. Employees are to follow prescribed safety and hygienic procedures. Work conditions include potential for prolonged standing, walking, sitting, climbing, stooping, kneeling, and crawling. Must be able to lift up to 100 pounds.
